Notes from last March 5th meeting

Defending the Gate - March 29

- * "Paint the Gate Day" rescheduled for Sunday, March 9 at the de Nedham home in King George
- * Baroness Esperanza will send out a plea for help at Defending the Gate, especially for assisting Lord Wolf on parking, and MOLs

- * Lady Heloise needs crockpots for night feast, returning crockpots can be worked out if you don't plan to stay for the feast
- * (From the MOO) Set up at the site on Friday, March 28 starting at 3pm
- * Be there!

Holiday Faire 2014

- * Budget proposal passed out by Lady Gunnora
- * Budget the same as last year with the following exceptions:
 - Add 25 chairs for court (rented in blocks of 25) for \$25
 - Add 5 6' tables for \$25
 - Also insurance for site \$50
 - Total \$2756, with an expected profit of \$2234
 - This passed with a thumbs up approval from the financial committee
- * No evening feast as the site cannot accommodate (space available has no heat/kitchen)
- * Discussion of a possible pre-court hospitality or snack bar
- * Menu for lunch to be set by next month so advertising can begin
- * A \$540 check is needed for the down payment and contract for the site, to be written and given to Gunnora
- * Merchant coordinator asked that extra tables and chairs be secured for renting to merchants as needed at the cost of \$2.50/chair and \$10/table
 - Chairs must be rented in blocks of 25
 - Baroness Esperanza mentioned rickety quality of tables in the past
 - Grimm and Gunnora will look into quality and report
